

What to do if you are worried about a child...

Member of staff has concerns about a child's welfare.

Where a young person discloses abuse or neglect, they (and the alleged abuser) SHOULD NOT be questioned further, but a record made of what has been said.

Social Worker & Manager 1. acknowledge receipt of referral 2. decide on next course of action (within one working day) feedback decision to referrer eg:

No longer has concerns No further child protection action Is this a child in need of other support? Consider with family and relevant agencies.

Remember to Log all incidents of behaviour or concern on Cpoms daily where the DSL will have access.
