What we are learning in school

- We are learning about the four seasons and how the world changes throughout the year.
- We will explore Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer and talk about what we see, feel and wear in each season.
- We will observe changes in weather, plants, animals, and daylight.
- We will read and retell stories linked to the seasons and use new vocabulary when speaking and listening.
- We will create seasonal artwork using paint, collage, printing and natural materials.

Talk About It at Home -

- Go on a seasonal walk and talk about what you can see outside.
- Ask your child - What season is it? How do you know?
- Notice the weather each day and talk about how it changes.
- Look at what clothes you wear in different seasons and why.
- Read seasonal stories together and encourage your child to retell them.
- Talk about foods you eat at different times of the year.
- Encourage your child to use new vocabulary such as change, cold, hot, grow and weather.
