

Remote Learning Plan



Reception Term 3

As we are in lockdown, the majority of children are accessing learning remotely via Seesaw and Zoom. School is open to Key worker and vulnerable children. The children accessing school provision will be accessing the same learning as those at home.

Below is a summary of what to expect from the remote learning this term:

Main areas of learning	Keyword practice Daily reading & Guided reading activities- inference, comprehension Name writing - continue to practise CVC word and Sentence writing Fine motor control exercises e.g. threading, playdough Counting to 8 and understanding the composition of the numbers 6, 7 and 8. (Identifying the numbers that make these numbers, comparing more and less) Managing change and establishing routines Dressing and undressing independently
How will online learning be organised?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Daily registers AM and PM via Zoom• Daily phonics videos and activities uploaded to Tapestry• Alternate English and Maths videos and activities uploaded to Tapestry• Reading books via Bug Club• Daily comprehension tasks uploaded to Tapestry• Topic activities uploaded to Tapestry• Small group Learn Together sessions via 'zoom' twice per week• Pre-recorded stories on Tapestry Tasks will be a mixture of online and practical – they will need access for live Learn Together sessions twice per week and to view the video prompts and tasks. Tapestry can be accessed on phones to view the tasks if necessary.
What additional support will be provided?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• An exercise book and pencil will be provided• We will provide assistance for those with limited internet access• Children with SEN will be given an intervention pack and extra video calling via 'zoom' may be arranged• Regular 'check in' phone calls to those not accessing the daily 'Zoom' sessions• If you need to speak to the teacher or require additional support, you can send messages on Seesaw or Tapestry and these will be answered within 24 hours between 8:30am and 4:30pm Monday-Friday
