Year 1 Term 3

As we are in lockdown, the majority of children are accessing learning remotely via Seesaw and Zoom. School is open to Key worker and vulnerable children. The children accessing school provision will be accessing the same learning as those at home.

Below is a summary of what to expect from the remote learning this term:

Main areas of learning	Spelling of Year 1 tricky words and Year 1 High frequency words. Applying phonics (Phase 2, 3, 4 and 5) to writing and reading Using and applying phonics to read nonsense words Writing in full sentences using a capital letter and full stop. Using the conjunction 'and' and 'but' to connect sentences. Writing sentences with ! and questions with ? Securing arithmetic skills (see arithmetic grid) e.g. number bonds to 10, adding 0, 1 more/less, ways of making a number to 10. Counting to 50 and beyond and back Using inference and deduction skills to understand what they have read
How will online learning be organised?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Daily registers AM and PM via Zoom• Daily phonics videos and activities uploaded to Seesaw• Daily English and Maths videos and activities uploaded to Seesaw• Reading books via bug club• Daily comprehension tasks uploaded to Seesaw• Small group Learn Together sessions via 'Zoom' twice per week• Pre-recorded stories on Tapestry• Children will upload work to Seesaw which will be marked and responded to by staff• Lesson will be provided for Learn Together, Science and Art. Tasks will be a mixture of online and practical – they will need access for live 'Zoom' sessions and to view the video recordings and tasks via Seesaw. Seesaw can be accessed on phones to view the tasks if necessary, however is easier for children to access via a tablet or laptop.
What additional support will be provided?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• An exercise book and pencil will be provided• We will provide assistance for those with limited internet access• Children with SEN will be given an intervention pack and extra video calling via 'zoom' may be arranged• Regular 'check in' phone calls to those not accessing the daily 'Zoom' sessions• If you need to speak to the teacher or require additional support, you can send messages on Seesaw or Tapestry and these will be answered within 24 hours between 8:30am and 4:30pm Monday-Friday
